Step aboard Grey Goose, a striking 70ft Widebeam crafted by Collingwood in 2019, and discover a thoughtfully designed floating home that blends elegant living with practical cruising. Built to an exceptional standard, this 2-bedroom, 4-berth vessel offers a contemporary reverse layout and every modern comfort you could wish for on the water — making her ideal for both full-time liveaboards and weekend retreats.

At the heart of Grey Goose is a powerful and reliable 60hp Canaline engine, paired with hydraulic wheel steering for a smooth and effortless navigation experience. Designed with extended cruising and off-grid living in mind, she boasts an impressive 8 leisure batteries, 1 starter battery, 600W of solar power, and a 2.5kW Sterling Pro Combi S inverter, giving you the confidence to explore without limits.

Her shore power connection, calorifier and immersion heater, and high-spec Vetus pump-out toilet system provide ease of use whether moored at a marina or travelling the network. Built with durability in mind, the hull has been treated with 2-pack epoxy from new, and the boat comes with a certificate of seaworthiness and seacock on the waste tank for peace of mind.

Enter through the stern into the beautifully appointed galley kitchen, where functionality meets contemporary flair. The heart of the space is the central island, finished with a warm wooden worktop and a Smeg 5-ring hob, perfect for preparing meals while socialising. Along the side, granite countertops host a stainless steel sink and a full suite of high-end appliances including a Smeg oven, grill, fridge, and freezer, plus a Panasonic microwave, slimline dishwasher, washer/dryer, and even a large wine cooler — all designed to make life on board as comfortable as life on land.

Moving forward, the open-plan saloon is a light-filled, welcoming space designed for relaxing and entertaining. A large skylight overhead floods the room with natural light, while plush carpeting and soft finishes create a homely feel. An electric fire adds instant warmth and ambience on cooler evenings, and a large Panasonic TV offers the perfect setup for movie nights in.

At the bow of the boat lies the luxurious master bedroom, a serene and spacious haven with doors opening out to the foredeck. A king-size bed with storage beneath takes centre stage, while a dressing table with pop-up TV, two large double wardrobes, and cleverly integrated shelving and drawers ensure plenty of space to store your belongings without cluttering the room. Whether you're waking to the gentle ripple of water or settling down with a film, this room offers peace and privacy in abundance.

The second bedroom provides a comfortable and private space for guests, children, or as a home office. It includes a fixed double bed, two generous double wardrobes, and a desk area — ideal for remote working, reading, or crafting.
