## Description

Step aboard Kazta, a meticulously restored 1977 Barney narrowboat, where vintage craftsmanship meets contemporary style. This rare 45-foot vessel (extended to 49 feet with a custom motorbike rack) is one of just 28 remaining Barney boats, making it a piece of history outfitted for a modern lifestyle.

Kazta's interior has been fully reimagined with a clean, bright aesthetic. The kitchen features sleek white cabinetry and oak countertops, with a striking feature wall that adds a splash of personality to the heart of the boat. Modern appliances, including a 12-volt fridge-freezer, 240V washing machine, and microwave, ensure that meal prep and daily chores are effortless.

The bathroom is a serene retreat, decorated in a rich blue, creating a dramatic contrast with the crisp white fittings. A full-size shower, round sink with vanity, and a cassette toilet (with three cassettes) provide both style and practicality. Every detail has been designed with comfort in mind, including the efficient Gulper pump for the shower.

Throughout the boat, a clean white interior is offset by oak laminate flooring, giving Kazta a timeless, polished look. The thoughtful layout includes bunk beds with a fold-away ladder, a spacious reclining leather sofa, and abundant sliding-door storage cabinets that maximize every inch of space.

Kazta is fully equipped for independent living, thanks to its robust energy systems. A 2400-watt solar array powers a 12-volt system with 120Ah lithium batteries, managed by a 2k inverter and VictronConnect technology. A dedicated alternator charges a new lorry-start battery, while a small solar panel ensures the engine is always ready to go. Wi-Fi, CCTV, and a 360° TV aerial on a retractable mast ensure you're always connected, even in remote locations.

The exterior of Kazta has been carefully restored to its former glory. The cabin top has been rebuilt with three coats of fiberglass and finished with durable 20-year roofing felt. A new front cratch cover adds to the sleek look, while the motorbike rack offers unique versatility for adventurers. (The rack can be removed if desired.)

Kazta isn't just a boat; it's a lifestyle. Every component, from the new wood-burning stove with a double-lined flue to the remote-controlled diesel heater, has been chosen for reliability and luxury. With its freshly rebuilt engine, reconditioned water tanks, and meticulous attention to detail, Kazta is ready to cruise or moor in style.
